Telling the full complex human history associated with the historic house is the mission of the Museum.

This history includes the **Indigenous people** who lived here for millennia before Europeans arrived, **English colonists** like William Trent, **Ioyal citizens of the British crown and patriots** fighting for independence, **wealthy families** of the Gilded Age **and their servants**, and **European immigrants and African American migrants** from the south who worked in the factories and lived in the neighborhoods surrounding the property.
